

## New edition of the Summer Course in Salzburg on International Legal Studies

The University of the Pacific: McGeorge School of Law organizes in the city of Salzburg, Austria, between July 1st and 20th, the Summer Program on International Legal Studies.

This initiative, in force since 1975, offers courses in international and comparative law in the fields of public and commercial law.

These summer courses taught in Salzburg are part of the European Summer Experience Courses organized by the professors of the McGeorge School of Law, which will feature lectures delivered by professors from universities around the world, including the presence of U.S. Supreme Court Associate Justice Anthony M. Kennedy (Ret.) and Dr. Wolfgang Brandstetter, Judge, Constitutional Court of the Republic of Austria, Special Advisor to the Commissioner of Justice of the European Union.

This year <u>4 courses</u> are offered, which will be taught in English, and the topics will be:

- Freedom of expression in Europe and the United States.
- Corporate Governance and Human Rights.
- European Law in Practice
- Democray and the Rule of Law.

The deadline to register for these courses will be next June 10. ICAM members may apply for a scholarship to cover the program tuitions. The number of scholarships is limited and will be granted to the first applicants.
